It is based on various pieces of information including teacher assessment and observations, class work, knowledge and understanding, development of key skills and test outcomes. There will be an online form on the parent tab of our school website for you to complete your parental comments. Your feedback is always appreciated.

Outcomes and Achievements

In the summer term our Y1, Y4 and Y6 children complete take statutory tests. We are really proud of their outcomes and wanted to share these with you.

85% of our Y1 children passed their phonics screening test and 50% of our Y4 children achieved full marks on their multiplication check, which is fantastic.

Key stage 2 test outcomes for reading, maths and grammar will be available next week. These will be published on our website when we have received them. Our Year 6 writing has been moderated and our judgements were validated, resulting in 79% achieving at the standard and 21% achieving above the standard.

We are really proud of how hard they have all worked and the resilience they have shown to do their best. Well done everyone.

All our staff would like to wish you all a safe and happy holiday and we look forward to welcoming the children back on **Tuesday 2**nd **September.**
