Road Safety

My Child at School

We would like to thank all of our parents for taking the time to register on the new parent app MCAS. This system replaces SCOPAY for the payment of dinners, snacks and trips.

(Please note, if you have an outstanding trip balance on SCOPAY you can use this system to make a payment, future trips will be raised through MCAS).

Please ensure that you have downloaded the MCAS app and enabled notifications in your app settings, on your mobile device. Moving forward, we will be using push notifications to alert you to communications and letters. You will see this as a pop up/notification on your mobile phone.

From January 2025, MCAS notifications will replace the current messaging service we use (Teachers to parents). So it is very important the app is downloaded and notifications are enabled. If you need any further support please contact the main office.

Pupils that had £16.10 on their SCOPAY account have received their snack as normal. Refunds have been issued for amounts above or below this value. Please note, we have been unable to refund amounts of less than £1, where the original payment was made several years ago or in cash. These balances can be checked on SCOPAY. If you would like the refund please contact school. Any small balances remaining will be added to our school fund in December 2024.
