It is based on various pieces of information including teacher assessment and observations, class work, knowledge and understanding, development of key skills and test outcomes. School Uniform Reminder

At Sunning Hill we do allow children to wear trainers. If your child chooses to wear trainers only **plain black or dark blue** can be worn. They **MUST** not contain any other colours (a white sole is acceptable). Children are not allowed to wear AstroTurf trainers for school.

Outcomes and Achievements

In the summer term our Y1, Y4 and Y6 children have to take statutory tests. We are really proud of their outcomes and wanted to share these with you.

93% of our Y1 children passed their phonics screening test and 63% of our Y4 children achieved full marks on their multiplication check.

In our KS2 tests: 69% achieved at the standard and 27% achieved above the standard in reading, 75% achieved at the standard and 24% achieved above the standard in writing, 78% achieved at the standard and 44% achieved above the standard in grammar and 80% achieved at the standard and 49% achieved above the standard in maths.

We are really proud of how hard they have worked and the resilience they have shown to do their best. Well done everyone.

All our staff would like to wish you all a safe and happy holiday and we look forward to welcoming the children back on **Monday 2**nd **September.**
