### Summer Term

- Royal blue sweatshirt
- Grey trousers, skirt or pinafore
- Blue or grey tights/leggings (white can worn in spring/summer)
- White and blue checked dress (spring/summer)

If your child chooses to wear a headscarf this must be plain royal blue or white.

- Plain black shoes or plain black/dark blue trainers PE kit
- Black or blue shorts or tracksuit bottoms
- Plain white t-shirt
- Black PE pumps or plain black/dark blue trainers
